### What you need to know...

- Your ticket - your Seat at the Party - gives you a seat at a table - we will provide the tables and chairs, but you are responsible for bringing your own food.
- Tables seat 8 people. If you want to buy a table, purchase 8 tickets.
- While we would love to accommodate your individual precise seat request, the event is too large to pull that off. Please just arrive at the event at 5 p.m. sharp and find your desired seat!
- The dinner event runs from 5 - 8 p.m. - however, half of Lincoln Square and down Baltimore Street to South Street will be closed from 2 - 10 p.m.

## Don't know anything about this event? Read on...

On **October 4th, from 5 to 8 p.m.**, The Long, Long, Long, Long Dinner Party will have tables that seat 8 stretching down the middle of a blocked-off Baltimore Street, all the way from Lincoln Square to South Street - a distance of four blocks. Guests can purchase their meals from a wide variety of food trucks and area restaurants; or they can bring their own potluck dinners from home. Also, a spirits tent will be set up on Lincoln Square. This is an open-air fundraising party, with entertainment and surprises, the whole town can enjoy with their families, friends, and neighbors. One ticket reserves one seat at the long, long, long, long dinner table. Tickets are \$15 per person and can be purchased online [here](#). Tickets still available on October 4 can be purchased at the event for \$20 per person.

## We are seeking sponsors for this event
