PA BROADBAND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY

Mission: To foster and create equitable, affordable, and robust high-speed broadband internet infrastructure and services connecting Pennsylvania for the 21st century and beyond.

Established by Act 96 of 2021

- Governed by 11-member board
 - Four members of the General Assembly
 - Secretaries for the Department of Agriculture, Community and Economic Development (DCED), Education, General Services, and the Budget
 - Executive Director of the Center for Rural Pa
 - Chairperson of the PUC
- DCED provides administrative and staff support
 - Continue to build staff capacity

Purpose:

- Single point of contact for state broadband initiatives and efforts
- Identifying and coordinating federal and state funding opportunities
- Developing and approving a statewide broadband plan



FEDERAL FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

The Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) has three main programs to support broadband development

- Broadband Equity, Access, and Deployment (BEAD)
- Digital Equity Act
- Middle Mile Infrastructure

The American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA)


- Capital Projects Funds (CPF)
 - \$279 million
 - Program plans under review

What is the difference in the data?

- Previous Map:
 - Census block level only

What is the Map?

- Implemented under Broadband Deployment Accuracy and Technology Availability (DATA) Act of March 2020
- Publicly accessible map, databased depicting where fixed and mobile broadband is available across the US
- NTIA will utilize this map to identify remaining BEAD funds to be allocated to states
- FCC National Broadband Map

- New Map: Two unique sets
 - 1) Broadband Serviceable Location: individual structures (i.e. homes, businesses) that can use broadband service
 - 2) Provider Submitted Data: Internet Service Provider (ISP) locations where broadband service is offered the FCC's Broadband Data Collection (BDC)

BDC Online Help Center provides a number of resources



IMPACT ON PENNSYLVANIA

- More accurately depict deficiencies
- Comprehensive vehicle that allows for a robust challenge process
- Ensure maximum BEAD allocation for the commonwealth
- Help local level governments and organizations to identify project areas
- Inform the Authority on areas of need when reviewing applications through future subgrant programs
- Allow for individual challenges, which means constituents may submit information directly to the FCC about the services received at their home/business






