2024 Bid Limits Announced

The PA Department of Labor and Industry has announced changes to the base amounts triggering the requirement for public bids, telephonic bids, or separate bids, for certain contracts. There is a 3.7%

change for this year, however, the increase is capped at 3%. Therefore, the base amount for public bids is \$23,200 and the base amount for written or telephonic bids is \$12,600, effective January 1, 2024. <u>Click</u> <u>here</u> for the complete list of base values.

In Luzerne County, Governor Shapiro Focuses on Work to Cut Costs for Pennsylvanians Through Expanded Child and Dependent Care Tax Credit, Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program – The expanded child and dependent care tax credit will put more money back into the pockets of nearly 210,000 working Pennsylvania families, while nearly 175,000 more Pennsylvanians will qualify for the PTRR program. In Luzerne County, more than 5,000 families will now receive a higher state childcare tax credit and more than 6,000 Pennsylvanians are now eligible for the expanded PTRR program.

<u>PA WalkWorks Active Transportation Planning Grant Round is Now Open!</u> – WalkWorks is pleased to announce its eighth round of assistance to advance policy development related to active transportation.



Grants and technical assistance will be offered to a limited number of municipalities and other governmental bodies to assist with the development of Active Transportation Plans during 2024 and 2025.
